## Preventing misconduct and questionable practices – a collaborative responsibility?

In response to spectaculare cases of scientific misconduct that have received profound media attention, many agencies, and countries have established rules and regulation about what misconduct is, and how it should be reported and punished, and many research institutions have introduced courses in research integrity and responsible conduct of research to teach new scientists what they ought (or ought not) do when conducting research. In this talk, I shall argue that to *prevent* scientific misconduct, we need also train collaborators, supervisors and mentors in how to detect and react to warning signs that something is 'strange', 'off', or 'too good to be true'.
